## No-Pick Center—Attendant cannot make exceptions

**Must** be Stratford resident or camp owner.

Trash **Must originate** in Stratford.

**Must have** sticker verifying residency and/or property ownership

**Residents** bringing trash or material in for non-resident friends or relatives **or non-resident property owners** bringing trash or material in from other towns increase our town taxes. Please report violations.

## ITEMS ACCEPTED

**Construction & Demolition Debris:** Asphalt pavement/roofing, bricks, concrete or masonry materials, drywall, electrical wiring, fixtures, glass, non-asbestos insulation, non-asbestos shingles/siding, plaster, plastic, plumbing PVC pipe\*, cast iron pipe\*, copper, sinks, toilets, bathtubs), wall coverings and wood, furniture, carpets and mattresses. Note: pipes shall be no longer than 4 feet.

**Charges for Construction & Demolition Debris:** As of April 1, 2021 charges are—\$10 small truck (load even w/side of bed body); \$15 full-size truck (load even w/side of body); \$30 1-ton dump truck (load even w/side of body); \$5 car trunk load/back seat load; free side passenger seat load. Single item and large loads are charged at discretion of operator; rates are—small bag or item or two, free. Exception—no charge for town bldg material. No commercial demolition accepted. As of June 12, 2006, no full house demolition accepted (owner must rent dumpster and pay hauling) + Tipping Fee.

**Recyclables:** soda cans, milk jugs, tin and aluminum cans, magazines, newspapers, #2 plastic and corrugated cardboard, cereal boxes, pizza boxes, beer and soda cardboard cases.

**Charges for Tires:** Tires are charged as follows: \$4.50 (car/small pickup tires), \$5 (large car/large pickup tires), \$3 (Microwaves).

**Other Acceptable Items:** Further items that are accepted are metal, tires, white good and glass only.

**Charges for General Items:** Refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners are \$10.00.

**Trash:** Household waste is accepted after recycled materials are removed and without any prohibited items in the waste.

**Paint Latex:** C&D when dried out from Speedy Dry or Cat Litter.

## ITEMS ARE NOT ACCEPTED

Asbestos and related items, fuel tanks are subject to Hazardous Waste Special Collection. Watch for special dates and disposal sites.

Free	Small bag or 1 to 2 small items carried
\$100	Shingles/Pick-up Load (see Attendant)

Thrift Shop	Decent clothes; decent shoes in pairs, clean stuffed animals in a tied plastic bag
<b>Electronics</b>	
\$20	Large television (over 27")
\$10	Mid-size to small television (under 27")
\$10	Computer monitor
\$10	Printer
\$5	Computer CPU
\$3	Radio
\$3	Microwave (any size)
\$3	Any other electronic device with cord (even if cord cut off)
FREE	Burn Pile Wood no larger than 6". (Clean Wood-see Attendant)
