

Selectmen/SOCC Meeting
December 16, 2020
6:30 p.m. at Fuller Town Hall

Selectmen present: Macdonald, Goulet and Juergens: Jamie Sayen, Bill Noons, Maryanne St. Jean, Molly Carr, Patrick Carr, Gregory Lamm and Suzanne Goulet

The Selectmen and the members of the SOCC agreed to meet to discuss issues with OHRV's on town roads.

Everyone agreed that the town needs to have a Town Policy concerning speed, operating single file, safety issues, etc.

There was much discussion concerning enforcement, speed, safety issues, signage, mapping, state guidelines, grants, town ordinances, lack of a Police Department, road damages, the fact that the trails are open for many other activities besides ATVing.

Signage was a big discussion. The town wanted to pay for all of the signs on town roads but the SOCC does not want to see any money to come from tax payers. Bill said that there are grants out there to pay for signs. Bill and Harry agreed to work together on which signs are needed and the locations for these signs.

There was continued discussion concerning mapping, state guidelines, the absence of any funds received by the town for damages to the town roads.

The biggest issue is enforcement. Discussion led to the cost of reinstating a town Police Department, State Police Coverage, hiring a retired Police Officer(s) for patrol, town ordinances, etc. Patrick was in attendance to help with the questions everyone had in reference these topics. It was suggested to have a discussion with other towns Police Department.

It was also discussed on and agreed to contact Scott Mason and invite him to a meeting.
