

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
July 20, 2020

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Clayton Macdonald.

APPOINTMENTS: Kitty informed the Board that she has hired someone for the open position in her office.

Kitty addressed the Board concerning a Timber Tax Abatement request. Macdonald/Juergens (3/0 denied) motion to deny the request for a Timber Tax Abatement.

Kitty addressed the Board with the Tax Deeding List.

Jamie addressed the Board concerning upcoming elections, some changes that may be coming for the safety of voters and elections workers pertaining to Covid-19.
