

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
July 6, 2020
Fuller Town Hall @ 3:30 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Clayton Macdonald.

APPOINTMENTS: Cindy, Allison and Christa addressed the Board concerning frequent fireworks and the affect it has on their dogs. The Board said that the town does not have an ordinance for this. The Board also said that they could start a signed Petition Warrant Article that would be needed for an Ordinance to be presented at Town Meeting.

Dick was in attendance at the request of the Board. The Board started by informing Dick that people have been complaining that he is advertising that he will furnish water, sewer and electricity for his campground and when they get there nothing is available. The Board also informed Dick that there has also been complaints about the loud music until late at night and that he is supposed to get a permit from the Board before having any events which he has not done. Dick told the Board that he has non-potable water, water from Bog Brook for people to use for washing up, a Porta-potty and he has one electrical pole. Dick also said that his guests are supposed to bring out what they bring in. The Board also discussed Fire Permits, Septic, if campers are registered and if not then he is to provide a list to the town for assessing purposes. Carlton was present as the Dep. Health Officer and discussed some of the health issues. Rachel asked the Board if it is okay to take water from Bog Brook?

Jamie addressed the Board concerning the upcoming elections, some of the effects of Covid-19, risks to election workers, the need to hire more election workers, safe guards that will be put in place for workers and the public, entry and exit plan, set-ups and absentee ballots. Jamie also said that he will be getting more information and will keep the Board up-to-date as the election gets closer.
