The Selectmen's Meeting was called to order by Charlie Goulet @ 3:30pm.

APPOINTMENTS: Denis Corbeil: Presented a bid for the construction of an open lean to, to be constructed at the transfer station.

Suzanne: JURY DUTY: Will be out of office Tuesday and Wednesday.

79E LIBRARY HALL: Presented form for Library Hall LLC 79E, 5 year period to begin at the date of recording.

YEATON: Heat options for the town garage. \$13,700 estimate. (Not in favor: ALL) Decided overpriced for our town at this time. Look into other estimates for modern and efficient energy. Danny Hebert potential for another estimate.

Goulet: Tire disposal has gone up to \$4.25 each to dispose of. We had a lot of tires and mattresses brought in from free dump day. Goulet would like to see more involvement for Clean-up Day, maybe some kind of competition/event. Caron to bring ideas to Conservation Commission. Decided to host a **SECOND FREE DUMP DAY JULY 16 8-12PM.**
