

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

APPOINTMENTS: A Group of citizens came to address the Board with concerns about OHRV's on Town Roads. After much discussion: Macdonald/Juergens (3/0 approved) motion to put a Moratorium in place restricting non-residential OHRV's on town roads, except Diamond Road and Old Mill Road, until the Public Hearing which was scheduled for October 9, 2020 at Fuller Town Hall at 6:00 pm and the Selectmen will use all input and make a decision in a timely manner.

Macdonald/Juergens (3/0 approved) motion for Suzanne to sign the Garland Mill Contract for the structural study of the Town Garage to make sure it is sound enough to hold solar panels.

Suzanne addressed the Board about a speed limit sign on Mason Rd. at the request of many residents on that road. The Board decided to purchase a speed limit sign in hopes that it will take care of the present problem.

Suzanne addressed the Board concerning the spray foam instillation at the Train Station/Library building and the Hollow Fire Department. The Board decided to go with Ben Blodgett to complete these jobs using the Hot Roof System.
