

Selectmen's Work Session
Water/Sewer Position/ATV's on Town Roads
December 14, 2020

The Board discussed the Water Budget with Carlton with few changes. Juergens/Macdonald (3/0 approved) motion accepted to Water Budget presented by Carlton.

The Board discussed the Health Budget with Carlton with no changes. Macdonald/Goulet (3/0 approved) motion to accept the Health Budget as presented by Carlton. Carlton did inform the Board that Claire and he will no longer be doing the Health Officer after June of 2021.

The Board discussed the FD Budget with Chuck with no changes. Juergens/Macdonald (3/0 approved) motion to accept to FD Budget presented by Chuck.

The Board looked at the applications and resumes sent by applicants for the Water/Sewer Position. After some discussion the Board decided to wait a couple more weeks before conducting any interviews.

The Board discussed the trees behind the Antique Shop that needs to be cut down before the town can install solar panels on the Town Hall Roof.
