

**Selectmen's Work Session  
Applications/OHRV's on Town Roads Policy  
December 28, 2020  
3:30 p.m. at Fuller Town Hall**

Selectmen present: Macdonald, Goulet and Juergens: Suzanne Goulet

Clayton brought the Work Session to order.

Suzanne presented the Board with the end of the year P&L and discussed the status of each department.

Suzanne discussed the poor quality of the town's second load of winter salt with the Board. The Company did suggest giving a discount or another load to the town. Suzanne will be calling to discuss the resolution.

Suzanne informed the Board that the Highways & Streets Budget is over and asked the Board if they would like the overage to come out of the remaining Operating Budget. Macdonald/Juergens (3/0 approved) motion to use the remaining Operating Budget to cover the overage in the Highways & Streets Budget.

Suzanne said that she is still waiting for a bill for the Furnace and installation at the Recycle Center which will also create an overage which will come from the R-Fund and Recycle Capital Reserve.

Suzanne informed the Board that the remaining funds in the General Fund (Conservation Commission) will be rolled over to the Conservation Fund.

Suzanne presented the Board with the rough draft of the Master Plan and would like the Board Members to bring them home, study them and present any questions or remarks to Rachel.

Suzanne presented the Board with an email answer from NHMA concerning a couple of issues (OHRV's on Town Roads/Class VI and Private Roads) with no real resolution to the questions. Clayton said that he would call and try to talk to them. The Board did discuss the Speed Limit for OHRV's on Town Roads. The Board decided that the Speed Limit would be 20 mph with reduction at sensitive areas as needed.

The Board discussed the two main applications for the Water/Sewer Position that have been received. The Board decided leave it open for anymore incoming applications for another week and to conduct these interviews on January 26<sup>th</sup> before the Work Session. Suzanne said that letters will be sent out to the applicants informing them of the date and time.

Suzanne said that she has been working on the insurance but still needs to contact NH Retirement.

Suzanne informed the Board that it is time to start working on the Warrant Articles and that the Board needs to be thinking of any possible Warrant Articles.

The Board discussed the possible adoption of a Site Plan Review Application for Stratford. This would mean that anyone wanting to build on Class VI or Private Roads would need to apply and get a Certificate before they can build, etc.

Macdonald/Juergens (3/0 approved) motion to adjourn the meeting at 4:55 pm.
