

**Selectmen's Work Session
PH/Public Rights-of-Way
October 20, 2020
3:30 p.m. at Fuller Town Hall**

Selectmen present: Macdonald, Goulet and Juergens: Jamie Sayen and Suzanne Goulet

Clayton brought the Work Session to order.

Jamie Sayen was present to discuss his feeling about the Public Hearing. He said that he heard some good ideas on both sides with the emphasis on enforcement. Now, we need ideas for how we can acquire enforcement and the funds to do so. There were business owners, residents and non-residents in attendance. We heard that Stratford only has OHRVs going for it. Jamie said that he would like to see a Citizen Discussion Committee and being able to keep the conversation going with possible solutions. Jamie agreed to do his best to get this committee started. He said that they could meet once a month at the town hall, try it for 6 months and see how it works.

After much discussion the Board began discussing each town road and the one's they believe should be opened to ATV travel with some new rules, signage, mapping, etc. The Board would like some clarification from NHMA concerning liability to the town. Harry said that he would work on the signage. The Board said that they would follow up at next weeks meeting with information that will be collected this week.

The Board decided to look over the revisions to the Land Use Ordinance and follow up on this issue at the next work session.

Suzanne addressed the Board about setting the new tax rate and a couple of options that they needed to decide on.

Suzanne addressed the Board concerning the Public Right-of-Way and the regulations and deadlines to adjust to our town from DT & C. The Board was very impressed the way it has been written and agreed on the \$100.00 Application Fee. The Board will approve at next Monday's Meeting.
