

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

May 18, 2015 – Fuller Town Hall @ 3:30 p.m.

Selectmen present: Brooks, Ladd and Davis: Michael Lynch

Tim began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mike came to talk to the Selectmen about the school hill. Mike said that he has not had time to get figures together but he will have them ready for the next meeting. The Selectmen asked Mike if he has started on Covey Rd. yet and he said that he would be starting Wednesday.

The Selectmen discussed putting a bid in the newspapers for the installation of a wider door in the downstairs hall and that they would like it advertised ASAP.

Chuck asked Suzanne to talk to the Selectmen about Protocol for dead animals and wrecker service. The Selectmen said that there is supposed to be a list of people at dispatch for when an animal gets hit or killed. The wrecker service should be revolving between Jamie Arsenault, Ted Burns and Randy LeClaire(if he is interested). Tim said that he would add this in the PD Contract.

Brenda Phillips house used 90,000 gallons of water and her bill will be between \$500-\$600. Suzanne wanted to know what the Selectmen wanted to do and they said that there has to be a break somewhere but it is the responsibility of the home owner if there are any problems from the meter to the house.

The Selectmen discussed putting a Press Release in the paper for the *NEW Town Website* and they decided that it really should be and they would also like the Free Day at the Transfer Station in the paper also as a Press Release.

Suzanne suggested that the Selectmen send Peggy Deyette a Thank You card and a monetary gift for volunteering to paint all of the playground equipment at both parks. The Selectmen said that they should send her a Thank You Card and a monetary gift for her time and talent. Tim said that he would also like the town to send a Congratulations Card to the Riverside Market & Deli on opening the store and wish them Good Luck.

The Selectmen were informed that Chuck cleaned out the Check Valve at the Fire Station and Sandra Theberge said that Kimball Hall has all kinds of water now.

The Selectmen were asked when they would like the ad in the newspaper for accepting applications for the PD and the Selectmen said that they are working on the Contract and the Job Description and they are still going to wait a little longer before advertising it.

The Selectmen were reminded about the Free Day at the Transfer Station, Saturday May 23rd from 8:00-12:00.

Claire Schooner and Carlton Harris went to the former Punk Christie property and she said that the sewer is draining into a 275 Gallon tank and that they were told to contact the town to have it pumped out.

The Selectmen decided that they would like to start getting money up front for Sewer Pumps.

Tim was asked when Community Service Day was and he said that it is Friday May 22nd and that the School Kids would be washing the windows and removing the storm windows at the Train Station and to let Chester know that they would be there after their parade.

The Selectmen viewed damage to the stone wall at the monuments and the newly painted park equipment. The Selectmen said that they would like Claude Houle called to fix the stone wall and they were very impressed with how nice the park equipment looks.

Michael Brauer asked if there was a non-public session at the end of the Hollow meeting May 4th and the Selectmen told him that they did not need to go into non-public since it was a public matter.

Vicki DeLalla said that the Grange would like to have a fund raiser to help with the lining of the chimney and the Selectmen said they would be happy to have the extra help with the cost of any of the repairs that need to be done.

Tim said that he will need to talk to the White's about pushing the stumps near the Baldwin Cemetery on their land over the bank.

Jamie gave Tim and Larry a copy of the information that he received about the LED Streetlights. Jamie said that he would like them to look it over and discuss it at the next meeting.

[Ladd/Davis (3/0 approved) motion to sign the Manifest and ordered the Treasurer to sign P/R Check #34334-#34335 in the amount of \$726.94 DD P/R Payments in the amount of \$1,658.46 and A/P Checks #34336-34350 in the amount of \$109,671.26 in the Selectmen's Office on 5/11/15(last week's manifest).

Ladd/Davis (3/0 approved) motion to sign the Manifest and order the Treasurer to sign P/R Check #34353-#34355 in the amount of \$452.22 and DD P/R Checks in the amount of \$1,683.10 and A/P Checks #34356-34366 in the amount of \$19,504.12 as presented on the Agenda.

Brooks and Ladd said that they would be coming in to sign the manifest next Tuesday since Monday is Memorial Day.

Ladd/Davis (2/0 approved) motion to accept minutes of April 20th. Brooks abstained since he was not present.

Ladd/Brooks (2/0 approved) motion to accept minutes of May 4th. Davis abstained since he was not present.

Reviewed Cost of the new mower-\$4831.50 will come from Sewer and \$4,831.50 will come from Capital Reserve.

Reviewed Information for Eversource Workshop.

Discusses request from First Baptist Church to put PVC pipe in the ground, below mowing level, at the Common to install their signs and the Selectmen thought that would be a good idea and for them to go ahead with it.

Reviewed letter from Dawn informing the Selectmen about an incident that happened last week. A young child almost fell down the stairs that go to the downstairs hall. Dawn had someone close the door and is now suggesting that the door be kept closed at all times. The Selectmen agreed.

Reviewed Library Trustee Minutes.

Tim handed out a copy of the PD Contract that he prepared to the other Selectmen to go over and make any changes or suggestions. Tim is waiting to get feedback for a date that is good for everybody on the PD Committee to meet.
