

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
June 27, 2016 - Fuller Town Hall @ 3:30 p.m.

Selectmen present: Ladd, Davis and Macdonald: Others present: Charles Goulet, Ben Blodgett and Suzanne Goulet. Larry started the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Suzanne told the Selectmen that the Grange Master came to report that the ceiling is sagging more and Jamie and Clayton said that they would like to go look at it.

Carlton Harris came in to have the Selectmen sign Claire Schooners and his Health Officers Renewals Forms.

Carlton was asked about the meter that was installed in the Post Office building and if it was in the Ordinance that the customer has to pay for any additional meters and Carlton said that he would check into it.

Suzanne talked to the Selectmen about the dispatch issue with Colebrook and the Selectmen said that they do not think that we should have to pay Colebrook since we already have an agreement with Lancaster for Dispatch.

Suzanne told the Selectmen that a State Trooper stopped into the office to see if he could use the PD Office and if they would still be allowed to use the PD Office even though there is not going to be an active PD and the Selectmen said that they would absolutely let the State Troopers use the PD Office.

One of the Selectmen said that he went to check out the Christie Road property that the town just took by tax deed and he said that it is very odd that they would let their property go like that. It was mentioned that they will have some time to repurchase the property after they received the 30-day letter from the town. The Selectmen wanted someone to try to contact these people somehow.

Suzanne showed the list of the properties that the town has acquired by tax deed this year. The Selectmen decided which ones were unable to be sold and the ones that they would need to take a look at. The Selectmen did decide to have some of the properties offered to the abutters but will need to wait the 90 days first.

Jamie said that the Tanko agreement is ready to sign.

Reviewed information on the meeting for the Pavilion. The Selectmen said that there was a pretty good turn out and that there are a few people that are interested in helping with the design and getting donations/grants and they will be scheduling a meeting in the near future.

Reviewed Driveway Permit for Travis Blodgett.

Reviewed Perambulation Letter from Northumberland informing us of their okay to go ahead with the plan for 2017.

Reviewed email from Dawn concerning the audit before she leaves. The email was from Tammy Letson saying that according to the RSA's it is not required but Tammy can go over the books, if that is what the Selectmen want, and that will be acceptable. The Selectmen decided that they would like Tammy to go over the books.
