

Selectmen's Work Session on PD Minutes
July 18, 2016
3:30 p.m. at Fuller Town Hall

Selectmen present: Ladd, Davis and Macdonald: Suzanne Goulet

Larry brought the Work Session on the PD to order at 3:30 pm.

Signed 4 30-Day Letters to people who's properties were taken by Tax Deed.

Signed Manifest dated 7/18/16.

Suzanne told the Selectmen that there was a complaint today that a Stratford Residents car was hit at night over the weekend and that they called the State Police. They said that the State Police said that if nobody saw the car get hit then all they need to do is go online, fill out an accident report and call their Insurance Company.

The Selectmen started with the discussion about the fact that Wayne's resignation was effective as of 7/10/16 and that he is still waiting for the State Police to do a closeout with him. The Selectmen decided that someone needs to call the State Police and ask where they are in this legal transition or process and what Wayne's position is.

The Selectmen also said that they wanted to get going with the Inventory of the PD. The Selectmen decided that they would like to meet on Thursday night at 6:00 pm if everyone involved is available. Clayton said that he would be available. Suzanne was asked, by the Selectmen, to call Stewart Walling and Wayne Hall to see if they are also available for that night and time.

The Selectmen discussed the Public Hearing and they decided on August 15th at 6:30 pm. The Selectmen also discussed who was going to do what in preparation for the Public Hearing. The Selectmen asked Suzanne to call the State Police and invite them to the Public Hearing along with asking them some questions that they have. The Selectmen discussed Budget, Salary, Part Time/Full Time, Benefits, etc.

After some discussion Clayton decided that he would facilitate the Public Hearing or maybe ask our Town Moderator, Jamie Sayen or even Greg Lamm to do so.

The Selectmen said that they would discuss their research findings at the beginning of the next Work Session on August 1st.

Davis/Macdonald (3/0 approved) motion passed to adjourn meeting at 4:54 a.m.
