

Selectmen's Work Session on PD Minutes
September 12, 2016
3:30 p.m. at Fuller Town Hall

Selectmen present: Davis, Ladd and Macdonald: Charles Goulet, Josiah Barnes and Suzanne Goulet

Jamie brought the Work Session on the PD to order at 3:30 pm.

The Selectmen discussed the Public Hearing and how the majority of the people would like their own PD.

The Selectmen discussed a breakdown of all of the 5 options for Police Coverage.

There was discussion about full-time benefits and Suzanne said that she would look up the State Law.

There was also discussion about sending someone to the Police Academy for training and the cost.

The Selectmen did discuss announcing at the Public Hearing the importance of having residents either dial 911 or the Lancaster Dispatch and not to use the Colebrook Dispatch.

There was discussion about the RSA that pertains to the presents of a Police Officer or not at elections.

There was also discussion about the handouts that should be available for the Public Hearing.

The Selectmen did discuss adding an Option 6 in case they cannot find anyone for a Police Officer.
