Macdonald/Goulet (2 voted yes): motion to enter nonpublic session under RSA 91-A:3, II (c) *Matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, **other than a member of this board**, unless such person requests an open meeting. This exemption shall extend to include any application for assistance or tax abatement or waiver of a fee, fine or other levy, if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant.* at 3:32 pm.

Suzanne reminded the Board that the Public Hearing on the Police Department is May 16<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm. The Board looked at and discussed the State Police Reports, their Contract and the cost. The Board discussed the inventory of the Police Department, equipment, cruiser and the Police Cruiser CR.

Chuck discussed the Police Radios and that they would just need to be reprogrammed with the new frequencies but in the very near future they would need to be replaced. Chuck also said that he would really like to see a quicker response time when there is an accident for example, the FD gets there and they have to wait for the State Police.

There was some discussion about a part-time Police Officer and how it may need to be a retired Law Enforcement Officer or a retired Fish and Game Officer.

The Board looked at and discussed the Agenda from the last PH on the Police Department, what they would like to add and delete.

The Board discussed having some kind of vote, at the end of the PH, to see what the town's people would like. It was decided that there will be an Opinion Poll by paper vote but that the final decision is going to be made by the Selectmen.
