

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
June 11, 2018
Fuller Town Hall @ 3:30 p.m.

Selectmen present: Davis, Macdonald and Goulet

Others present: Rachel O'Meara, Wayne Labatte, Larry Ladd and Suzanne Goulet.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Chairman Jamie Davis.

APPOINTMENTS: Suzanne addressed the Board about the repairs to the tops of the Triangle Monuments and a quote that we are expecting from Chimney Pro. Chimney Pro said that they would fix the corners of the Triangle for no extra charge.

Suzanne addressed the Board about the Marcy Property, Confirmation from the Sheriff's Dept. and information that the property has seen some improvement. The Board decided to check it out and will decide if they will want to go further with the procedures and if they want DES to come to inspect.

Suzanne addressed the Board with the information that Dave Potter has rescinded his application for a Junkyard.

Suzanne addressed the Board informing them that she has been in contact with the State Police and that their service will end the last day of June.

Suzanne addressed the Board about Mr. Curley's request for a Private Sign to be attached to the road sign where he lives. The Board said after some research the town has never provided Private Road Signs. Wayne said that he owns ½ of that road and Mrs. Dunkerly owns the other ½ of that road. Goulet/Macdonald (3/0 approved) motion to deny the request from Mr. Curley for a Private Road Sign.

The Board discussed mowing, the budget for mowing and some complaints about mowing getting done too soon in the fall. Joe Hakey also is requesting landscaping fabric and mulch to go under the bleachers at the ballfield. The Board asked Suzanne to talk with Joe.

The Board discussed the watering of the flowers for the summer, the potential schedule for volunteers and a possible Storage Area for supplies.

The Board discussed the trees to be planted, Jamie said that he would get in contact with Chris Caron.
