

Selectmen's Work Session on Road/Roads Contract
August 13, 2018
6:00 p.m. at Fuller Town Hall

Selectmen present: Davis, Macdonald and Goulet: Ted Burns, David White, Anthony Gray and Suzanne Goulet

Jamie brought the Work Session to order at 6:00 p.m.

Ted was present at the request of the Selectmen to discuss ATV's on the sidewalks. After some discussion everyone agreed that better signage was needed and Ted said that he would make it happen.

The Board asked Ted if he knew who got the bid for the Bog Rd. reconstruction and he said that he hasn't heard anything.

David White was present at the request of the Selectmen to discuss the mowing of the town roads and their concerns about the Invasive Species in those areas. Clayton said that he would like to ride the roads with David and they agreed on 10:00 am tomorrow. Goulet/Macdonald (3/0 approved) motion to hire David to mow the town roads and to allow him to get started as soon as possible.

Anthony Gray was in attendance since he has some interest in the Road Agent Position for the town.

Suzanne discussed the Budget and Capital Reserve for Roads with the Board.

The Board also discussed Winter Road Maintenance verses Summer Road Maintenance, road conditions/priorities, contracting for plowing only, splitting the town into two parts, advertising and discontinuing the maintenance of some roads (to be re-visited again in one year).

The Boards also had a short discussion about the pavilion.

Davis/Goulet (3/0 approved) motion passed to adjourn meeting at 7:30 p.m.
