

**Selectmen's Work Session  
Town Roads  
May 29, 2019  
6:30 p.m. at Fuller Town Hall**

Selectmen present: Davis, Macdonald and Goulet: Suzanne Goulet

Jamie brought the Work Session to order at 6:30 p.m.

The Board discussed what roads they would like to do maintenance on before they turn into major projects.

The Board discussed the Spring Grading and which roads should be graded. The Board decided to exempt Covey Rd., Theberge Rd., Town Line Rd., Fuller Rd., Paradise Rd. and the East end of Percy Rd. from Spring Grading. The Board would also like to exempt Christie Rd. from the Spring Grading due to upcoming repairs. The Board will look at the list again when it comes time for the Fall Grading.

The Board took each of the remaining roads and discussed what kind of maintenance and culvert issues that is needed on each road. It was also discussed about contacting landowners/contacts concerning the fixing of their culverts.

The Board also discussed a couple of water shutoffs that need to be covered before the grading can be done.

The Board discussed the Spring Sweeping and Road Side Mowing. The Board discussed getting a list of the roads that will need mowing to David White by mid-July.

The Board decided to make Christie Rd. the main project this summer since it is a safety issue. They also decided to do some minor work on Kimball Rd., fix a washout on Mason Rd. and get some new estimates for paving on Stevens Terr. and Old Mill Rd.
