Second set of donor bricks installed at Stratford pavilion

The second round of the brick fundraiser for Stratford's timber-frame pavilion closed in late spring this year and now 43 new bricks have been added to the existing brick area. The engraved bricks are displayed in a floor area right in front of the new stage, which was added this summer.

"The Town of Stratford is very happy about the ongoing support from both residents and out-of-town supporters", says Suzanne Goulet, the town's administrative assistant. "We would like to remind everyone that our beautiful pavilion is available for rent; we've had a few birthday parties and graduation events held there already".

For local donors who would like to look at their newly installed bricks, this fall is serving up two occasions to stop by and do so: on September 28, the Cohos Historical Society is holding their annual corn-hole tournament at the pavilion. A week later, on October 5, a Fall Festival takes place, held by the North Stratford Baptist Church and Saturdays on the Common. Both events will feature food and live music.
