

**Selectmen's Meeting Minutes**  
**September 16, 2019**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Clayton Macdonald.

Suzanne addressed the Board about Rose Connary filling the vacant position as Cemetery Trustee. Goulet/Macdonald (2/0 approved) motion to approve the appointment of Rose Connary for Cemetery Trustee until Town Meeting.
