

Stratford Town Office open to the public again

Accepting walk-ins on a “one-at-a-time” basis

On June 15, 2020 the Stratford, NH Town Offices are re-opening to the public. To ensure social distancing and to reduce risk of exposure, we will admit visitors one-at-a-time for service at either window.

Appointments are no longer required – please be patient as you wait outside. Some seating will be provided.

Please follow these guidelines to ensure the safety of our community:

- For your health and the health of others, **we encourage that you use hand sanitizer and wear a face covering** while in the building. If you don't have your own, we provide a sanitizer station and have masks available right by our entrance.
- Don't forget to **bring your own pen!** Less sanitizing for us to do...
- **If you are not feeling well**, we ask that you refrain from entering the building.
- In order to minimize foot traffic at the Town Hall, **we strongly encourage residents to continue to make use of our remote services** either by mail or using our online payment tools.
- You may also use the **drop-box** at our main entrance for any forms or payments you wish to simply drop off at the Town Office.
