# ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF VEHICLES UPON TOWN ROADS

The Town of Stratford by its Board of Selectmen duly authorized in accord with RSA 31:39(g) does hereby adopt the following Ordinance Regulating the Operation of Vehicles Upon Town Roads:

1. It shall be unlawful for any vehicle, with or without its load, in excess of ten tons in weight, to operate on the following Town Roads:

The Old Mill Road, so-called;
Bog Road, so-called;
Bordeau Road, so-called;
Christie Road, so-called;
Tetreault Road, so-called;
Percy Road, Route 3 Entrance;
Egan Road, so-called, except that the Bridge on such road shall have a limit of ten tons;
and
Percy Road-Bog Road entrance, except that

Percy Road-Bog Road entrance, except that the Bridge on such road shall have a limit of ten tons.

- 2. This Ordinance shall not apply to operation of school buses on the regularly scheduled school bus routes.
- 3. Anyone convicted of violating this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000) for each violation thereof.

# Ordinance Regulating the Operation of Motorized Vehicles on Town Properties

The Town of Stratford by its Board of Selectmen duly authorized in accordance with RSA 41:11 VII, VIII, and XVIII and RSA 47:17 does hereby adopt the following Ordinance Regulating the Operation of Motorized Vehicles on Town Properties:

- 1. It shall be unlawful for any motorized vehicle, including but not limited to trail bikes or all-terrain vehicles or snow machines, to operate on the following Town properties located at the streets so identified:
  - **Back Street**—basketball court, tennis court, playground, ball field, and sewer beds, excepting for marked trail(s), if any, to access residences at the Village end of town.
  - US RT 3/Old Mill Road—sewer beds, excepting for marked trail(s), if any at the Village end of town.
  - **Hollow Road**—Hollow Memorial Field playground and basketball court at the Hollow end of town.
  - **Bog Road**—sewer bed, excepting for market trail(s), if any at the Hollow end of town.
- 2. This Ordinance shall not apply to the operation of non-motorized tricycles and bicycles.
- 3. Anyone convicted of violating this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) for each violation thereof.
- 4. This ordinance shall supersede the previously approved ordinance on Operation of Motorized Vehicles Upon town Parks, adopted 1 October 2001.
